- 1) Stem Stitch with DMC #975 using 2 strands of floss. Stem Stitch over 1 horizontal and 4 vertical threads (you will need compensation stitches at the beginning and ending of the row).
- 2) Cross Stitch using 2 strands of floss in color indicated by the symbols (Each cross stitch covers two vertical and two horizontal threads).
- 3) Backstitch using one strand of floss. DMC #938 for basket and kitten whiskers, #975 for kitten, and #814 for outer edge of border.

Finish as desired.
